Whereas, he is widely known as Tucker's unofficial Goodwill Ambassador; and

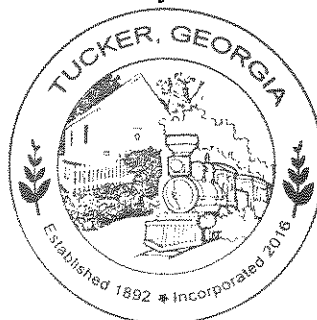
Whereas, he often walks miles each day to attend every sort of event and meeting; and
