DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY IN THE CITY OF TUCKER AND
REMEDATING THE ECONOMIC EFFECTS IN RESPONSE
TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC CRISIS

WHEREAS, the City of Tucker, Georgia is currently experiencing an event of critical significance as a result of the spread of the COVID-19 coronavirus; and

WHEREAS both the President of the United States and the Governor of the State of Georgia have declared national and state emergencies, respectively; and

WHEREAS the Governor extended the state of emergency in Georgia with executive order 4.23.20.02; and

WHEREAS the executive order 4.23.20.02 states that municipal governments are authorized and empowered to make, amend, and rescind such orders, rules, and regulations as may be necessary for emergency management purposes and supplement carrying out this order, but such rules shall not be inconsistent with the order; and

WHEREAS, significant detrimental economic effects have occurred with both businesses and residences from the Governor's shelter in place order 04.02.20.0; and

WHEREAS, the shelter in place order placed a significant burden on both the cash flow and quarterly profits of local businesses; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Mayor of the City of Tucker, there exist emergency circumstances located in the City requiring extraordinary and immediate corrective actions for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and businesses of the City of Tucker; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Tucker desires to provide immediate economic relief to local businesses; and

WHEREAS, extending the date for local businesses to pay occupational taxes without incurring a penalty supplements the Governor's order 4.23.20.02 and does not conflict with said order; and

WHEREAS, a state of emergency has been declared is in effect for the State of Georgia;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by local and state law;


IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that a state of emergency continues to exist and the economic effects of the declared state of emergency needs immediate action.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


(1) The date for local businesses within the city limits of Tucker to pay occupational taxes to the City of Tucker without incurring a penalty is hereby extended until May 31, 2020.

(2) The declaration of emergency shall supersede any previous declarations and shall be effective for 30 days, unless expressly extended or terminated.
