

City of Tucker Parks and Recreation Beautification Project Application



The City of Tucker Parks and Recreation Department and Park Pride will work with neighborhood groups and interested organizations to provide cleanup supplies, tools, and safety information. The beautification area in the park will be identified by the project coordinator and discussed with a representative from Park Pride and City of Tucker Parks Representative prior to the work-day. The project application will be completely filled out, turned in and processed 10 business days prior to the work-day to ensure that the request can be met. Supplies must be picked up at 3681 Chestnut Street in Scottdale, GA prior to the work-day; dumpsters will be delivered to the best of our ability by the Friday before the scheduled work-day, if requested. On the actual clean-up day, *all volunteers must sign the attached waiver form (last page) and return to Park Pride*. Once the clean-up is complete, the borrowed supplies need to be returned by the project coordinator the next business day following the work day.

Approved Project Ideas

- **Cleanups** – A clean-up project can focus on removing trash and debris from general park areas and around lakes. The project should not only cleanup the site, but also include a strategy for preventing future illegal dumping.
- **Invasive plant removal** – Removing invasive plants, such as kudzu, English ivy, and privet, from general park areas will encourage the life cycle of native plant species and animal life. Any areas where plants are to be removed need to be identified prior to the work-day and all native species are to be identified and left untouched.

Ideas/Projects Requiring Approval

- **Events involving alcohol, sound amplification, or otherwise require permitting**
- **Tree/shrub planting** – Reduce pollution, add shade, prevent erosion, and improve the value of your park for decades to come by planting trees at a recreation center, along a stream bank, or in general park areas. Any areas where plants are to be installed need to be identified prior to the work-day and any species planted will need to be authorized by parks personnel. In times of drought or water restrictions, trees and plant projects will not be allowed. Tree plantings are restricted between the months of December and March.

City of Tucker reserves the right to limit the use of volunteers, adjust the hours of any volunteer or to reject services as it, in its sole discretion, deems fit, in order to best achieve its public purpose and policy. No employment of any other contractual right is created by these policies. Participation in any volunteer position of the City shall be open to any individual and no individual shall be discriminated against based upon race, color, religion, age, sex, national origin or physical, mental or sensory handicap, or on the basis of any other characteristic protected by law.

Under no circumstances shall a volunteer operate any heavy power equipment. Regular household daily yard equipment is acceptable i.e.-blower, weed eater, mower. Chain saws and other heavy equipment is not permitted. City owned or contracted mowers, weed-eaters, chain saws, backhoes and/or other large construction equipment will be operated by City staff/contractors and not volunteers. Miscellaneous construction equipment may be donated, used and operated, and approved by City of Tucker Parks and Recreation. All volunteers conducting work on City of Tucker park property must complete the waiver before work is to begin.
