BABYSITTERS TRAINING W/PEDIATRIC CPR

The American Red Cross Babysitter's Training with Adult & Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED course prepares youth ages 11-16 to care for children and infants safely and confidently. It includes hands-on activities, videos, and discussions to develop essential real-life readiness babysitting skills. The course covers feeding, diapering, picking up and holding, children's safety and emergency response. We want to prepare participants well for emergencies, but CPR can be physically demanding, and participants should ideally weigh at least 85-90 pounds to participate in this portion of the course. Successful completion awards a 10-year Babysitter's Training certificate and a 2-year Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED certificate.

BASIC LIFE SUPPORT (BLS)

The 2021 Basic Life Support (BLS) course provides healthcare providers and public safety professionals with the knowledge and skills necessary to respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies in adult/child and infant patients. This class is taught in a blended learning format, and the online portion (accessed via mobile desktop or tablet) must be completed prior to attending the instructor-led skills session. Upon successful completion of the course learners will receive a 2-year Basic Life Support digital certificate with anytime anywhere access to certificate and training history.

CPR/FIRST AID

The 2021 Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED blended learning course equips students to recognize and care for a variety of first aid breathing and cardiac emergencies involving adults, children, and infants. It is designed for students who need a certification that satisfies OSHA workplace or other regulatory requirements. This class is taught in a blended learning format, and the online portion (accessed via mobile desktop or tablet) must be completed prior to attending the instructor-led skills session. Upon successful completion a valid 2-year digital certificate for Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED is issued.

CPR INSTRUCTOR

This course will train instructor candidates to teach basic-level American Red Cross First Aid CPR and AED courses. To participate in this course, you must possess a current basic-level American Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED (or higher level) certification or equivalent and be at least 16 years of age on the last day of the instructor course. Upon registration it is important that you review and follow the directions on the e-mail attachment sent with your registration confirmation.
