PURPOSE, INTENT AND PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The City of Tucker (City), requests that interested parties submit formal electronic bids to provide, deliver, and install new aluminum bleachers at the new turf field in Fitzgerald Park located at 4877 Lawrenceville Highway, Tucker, GA 30084. The respondent will be responsible for providing all materials, equipment, shipping/delivery, installation, and labor associated with this project. This document in its entirety, including the Scope of Work, specifications, and other relevant information for ITB 2025-006 is available for download on the Georgia Procurement Registry Website and the City of Tucker website http://tuckerga.gov/bids , the DOAS/Georgia Procurement Registry Website or may be requested by emailing procurement@tuckerga.gov.

BACKGROUND

This project is turn-key. The park is ending an extensive renovation project. Installation of the bleachers will be on an existing concrete pad.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

The contractor shall provide and install a product according to and meeting the requirements of the following:

- Non-elevated, max 140' length; max 28' width (depth); height (12 15 rows) TBD to meet seating capacity request and fit in described dimensions.
- Net minimum seating capacity is 750 with minimum 10 ADA seats included.
- Aluminum angle understructure with 8" Rise / 24" Run.
- 2 x 10 anodized aluminum seat plank with poly end caps.
- Double 2 x 10 mill finish aluminum foot plank with aluminum end caps.
- Required number of 4'-6" wide vertical aisle with mid aisle handrail.
- Chain link guardrail system
- Concrete wedge anchors
- Galvanized hardware
- Small press box system (integrated w/bleacher system, if available)

NOTE: All applicable power and scoreboard wiring will be completed by City.

The contractor will be responsible for providing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to perform the work. This is a lump sum bid. Payment will be made based on the actual work completed.

The contractor is responsible for inspecting the jobsite prior to submitting a bid. No change orders will be issued for differing site conditions.

The successful bidder must have verifiable experience at construction of similar projects in accordance with these specifications. Bidder shall provide at least three references, including company name, project name, contact name, phone number and email address, demonstrating experience successfully completing projects of similar scope.

5% retainage will be withheld from the total amount due the contractor until Final Acceptance of work is issued by the City. The City will inspect the work as it progresses.

PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS

The Contractor will mobilize with sufficient forces such that all construction identified as part of this contract shall be substantially completed by August 31, 2025. The contractor will be considered substantially complete when all work required by this contract has been completed (excluding punch list work).

Upon Notice of Award, the Contractor will be required to submit a Progress Schedule.

The normal workday for this project shall be 8:00AM to 7:00PM and the normal workweek shall be Monday through Friday. The City will consider extended workdays or workweeks upon written requests by the Contractor on a case by case basis. No work will be allowed on national holidays (i.e. Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, etc.).

The work will require bidder to provide all labor, administrative forces, equipment, materials and other incidental items to complete all required work. The City shall perform a Final Inspection upon substantial completion of the work. The contractor will be allowed to participate in the Final Inspection. All repairs shall be completed by the contractor at contractor's expense prior to issuance of Final Acceptance.

The contractor shall be assessed liquidated damages in the amount of \$500.00 per calendar day for any contract work (excluding punch list and permanent striping) that is not completed by August 31, 2025. Liquidated damages shall be deducted from the 5% retainage held by the City. The contractor will also be assessed liquidated damages in the amount of \$500.00 per calendar day for not completing any required Punch List work within 45 calendar days.

The contractor shall provide all material, labor, and equipment necessary to perform the work without delay until final completion.

The contractor shall submit a two-week advance schedule every **Friday by 2:00p.m**, detailing scheduled activities for the following week.

PERMITS AND LICENSES

The contractor shall procure all permits and licenses, pay all charges, taxes and fees, and give all notices necessary and incidental to the due and lawful prosecution of the work.

BONDING AND INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the time has been called on the date of opening.

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond of a reputable bonding company authorized to do business in the State of Georgia, in an amount equal to at least five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid.

Upon Notice of Award, the successful contractor shall submit a Performance Bond payable to the City of Tucker in the amount of 100% of the total contract price. The successful contractor shall also submit a Payment Bond in the amount of 100% pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-91-70 and 90.

The contractor shall procure and maintain the following insurance policies:

1. Commercial General Liability coverage at their sole cost and expense with limits of not less than \$3,000,000 in combined single limits for bodily injury and/or property damage per occurrence, and such policies shall name the City of Tucker as an additional named insured.

- 2. Statutory Workers Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance with limits of not less than \$1,000,000, which insurance must contain a waiver of subrogation against the City of Tucker and its affiliates.
- 3. Commercial automobile liability insurance with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit for bodily injury and/or property damage per occurrence, and such policies shall name the City of Tucker as an additional named insured.

SUBCONTRACTING

The contractor shall not subcontract the complete Work, or any portion thereof, without prior written approval. Any Contractor utilizing a subcontractor must submit a proposed list of subcontractors (form provided) and upon contract award, shall provide a Notarized Subcontractor Affidavit (form provided) for each subcontractor.

EXISTING CONDITIONS / DEVIATION OF QUANTITIES

All information given in this ITB concerning quantities, scope of work, existing conditions, etc. is for information purposes only. It is the Contractor's responsibility to inspect the project site to verify existing conditions and quantities prior to submitting their bid. This is a Lump Sum bid and no payment will be made for additional work without prior written approval from the City. At no time will Contractor proceed with work outside the prescribed scope of services for which additional payment will be requested without the written authorization of the City.

The City reserves the right to add, modify, or delete quantities. The City may also elect to add or eliminate certain work locations at its discretion. The Contractor will not be entitled to any adjustment of unit prices or any other form of additional compensation because of adjustments made to quantities and/or work locations. The contractor will be paid for actual in-place quantities completed and accepted for pay items listed in the Bid Schedule. All other work required by this ITB, plans, specs, standards, etc. but not specifically listed in the Bid Schedule shall be considered "incidental work" and included in the bid prices for items on the Bid Schedule.

PROTECTION AND RESTORATION OF PROPERTY AND LANDSCAPE

The contractor shall be responsible for the preservation of all public and private property, crops, fish ponds, trees, monuments, highway signs and markers, fences, grassed and sodded areas, etc. along and adjacent to the highway, road or street, and shall use every precaution necessary to prevent damage or injury thereto, unless the removal, alteration, or destruction of such property is provided for under the contract.

When or where any direct or indirect damage or injury is done to public or private property by or on account of any act, omission, neglect or misconduct in the execution of the work, or in consequence of the nonexecution thereof by the contractor, he shall restore, at his/her own expense, such property to a condition similar or equal to that existing before such damage or injury was done, by repairing, rebuilding or otherwise restoring as may be directed, or she/he shall make good such damage or injury in an acceptable manner. The contractor shall correct all disturbed areas before retainage will be released.

CLEANUP

All restoration and clean-up work shall be performed daily. Operations shall be suspended if the contractor fails to accomplish restoration and clean-up within an acceptable period of time. Failure to perform clean-up activities may result in suspension of the work.

SAFETY

Beginning with mobilization and ending with acceptance of work, the contractor shall be responsible for

providing a clean and safe work environment at the project site. The contractor shall comply with all OSHA regulations as they pertain to this project.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The concrete pad in which the bleachers will be installed is not a part of this scope. It is an existing pad.
